Project Description

A public charter school operating as the El Camino Real Charter School Independent Study Program (ISP) serving grades 9 through 12 with a maximum of 150 students for on-site instruction daily. The ISP is proposed on a site improved with a one-story, 22.3 foot in height, 15,025 square foot existing facility that includes nine classrooms, a multi-purpose room with no fixed seating, a meeting room, and surface parking accommodating 78 automobile parking spaces and 12 bicycle parking spaces. The public charter school was previously approved under Case No. CPC-2016-1256-CU and the applicant is currently requesting a Conditional Use permit with modified conditions of approval.

Under the requested modifications, the applicant is proposing two signs accessory to the school use: (1) an approximately 77.1 square foot, non-illuminated wall sign on an east facing wall that surrounds the parking lot at the southern portion of the site; and (2) an approximately 2.4 square foot, non-illuminated wall sign on an east facing wall at the school frontage.
